

1. Purpose

- 1.1. The College currently has Electric Vehicle (“EV”) charging points at its London Road and Welsh Bridge campuses. This policy provides guidance regarding the use of EV chargers on college premises.

2. Who may access College EV charging points

- 2.1. EV Charger units may be used by any user of the campus or member of the public using the College’s London Road sports facilities or Welsh Bridge parking facilities on payment of the appropriate tariff in force at that time.
- 2.2. Users are asked to vacate EV spaces promptly, where possible, in consideration of other campus users and to allow others to access the EV charging facilities.
- 2.3. In circumstances where the car park is busy and other spaces cannot be found, it is accepted that users may use an EV parking space even though they do not intend to use the EV charger.

3. Charges for access to EV charging points

- 3.1. All EV charging points have the facility to take payment directly at the point of use. Payment must be made electronically directly at the point of use using either the card payment facility on the EV charging unit or via the **CLEnergy** EV payment app.
- 3.2. No additional charges are currently in force regarding any “over-stay” by users parking in an EV parking space or occupying an EV charging unit by leaving a charged vehicle connected after its charging session has finished.
- 3.3. The the tariff for power is made visible to the user on the EV charging unit screen and via the Clenergy App. The Executive Director of Finance shall be responsible for setting and review of the tariff charged from time to time.

4. Appropriate use of EV charging points

- 4.1. Abuse of, or interfering with an EV charging point is potentially dangerous and considered to be a serious matter (equivalent to theft or damage or destruction of property) and gross misconduct.
