

1. Purpose

- 1.1. This procedure sets out the arrangements for the nomination, election and appointment of Staff Governors to the Corporation of ~~Governing Body of~~ Shrewsbury College, in accordance with statutory requirements.
- 1.2. In accordance with the Instrument and Articles of Government, the Corporation must include at least one member of staff.
- 1.3. The Corporation has determined that there shall be three Staff Governors.

2. Composition of the Board of Governors for Shrewsbury College

- 2.1. Where the Corporation has decided that there are to be three staff members, the members may be members of the academic staff or the non-academic staff and shall be nominated and elected by all eligible staff.

3. Election and Appointment of Staff Governors

- 3.1. Staff Governors serve a term of up to four years. A vacancy may arise due to:
 - Completion of a term of office.
 - Resignation.
 - Loss of eligibility to serve.
 - Disqualification under the Instrument and Articles of Government or other relevant legislation.
- 3.2 When a vacancy occurs:
 - Nominations will be sought from the eligible staff cohort entitled to nominate and elect the Staff Governor.
 - If more than one nomination is received, an election will be held.

4. Appointment

- 4.1. Following the conclusion of the election process, the outcome shall be reported to the Corporation.
- 4.2. The successful candidate(s) shall be formally appointed by the Corporation.
