

1. Purpose

This procedure sets out the arrangements for the nomination, selection and appointment of Student Governors to the Corporation of Shrewsbury College.

2. Number of Student Governors

- 2.1. In accordance with the Instrument and Articles of Government, the Corporation must include at least one Student Governor.
- 2.2. The Corporation has determined that there shall be two Student Governors:
 - One representing students aged 16-19.
 - One representing students aged 19 and over.
- 2.3. Student Governors must be enrolled as students of the college throughout their period of office.

3. Term of Office

- 3.1. Student Governors shall normally serve a term of office determined by the Corporation, up to a maximum of four years.
- 3.2. The term of office may be adjusted to reflect the expected duration of the student's programme of study.

4. Vacancies

- 4.1. A vacancy may arise through:
 - Completion of a term of office.
 - Resignation.
 - Loss of student status.
 - Disqualification under the Instrument and Articles of Government or applicable legislation.
- 4.2. A Student Governor shall cease to hold office on ceasing to be a student of the college or at the end of the final academic year, unless the Corporation determines otherwise.

5. Nomination and Selection Process

- 5.1. When a vacancy arises, the Board shall seek nominations from the eligible cohort or such other representative student body as may be recognised by the college through a fair and transparent process for identifying nominees.
- 5.2. Where more eligible candidates are nominated than there are vacancies, a selection or election process shall be undertaken.
- 5.3. The outcome shall be notified to the Clerk to the Corporation.

6. Appointment

- 6.1. Following receipt of the nomination, the Clerk shall confirm the student's eligibility for appointment.
- 6.2. The nomination shall be reported to the Corporation.
- 6.3. The successful candidate shall be formally appointed by the Corporation.

7. Induction and Support

- 7.1. Student Governors will receive an induction appropriate to their role and ongoing support to enable them to participate effectively in the work of the Corporation and its committees.
