# Task 1: Inspiration

Use both primary and secondary research:

- Aim for between 8-16 images across a mix of areas

Giambattista Valli is an Italian fashion designer from Rome, Italy. His collections, both ready-to-wear and Haute Couture, are presented semi-annually during Paris Fashion Week.
